## The Magical Tarot Session One Notes

Tarot is a pictorial blue-print of the Path of human evolution, and a tool we can use to intentionally advance along that path. As we do so, we master more and more energy and manifest more and more splendor of ourselves and our lives.

Each image shapes and stimulates your subconscious to awaken you to the wisdom it represents.

This wisdom was kept secret because the forces of world domination sought to destroy it to keep humanity under their control.

That wisdom consists of the way to properly channel of Divine Energy, a process we term "Mastery". Embodying the images produces a magical operation that manifests the fulfillment of your Divine Potential and manifests heavenly conditions on earth.

## Key 0:

- The fulfillment of our limitless potential is the purpose of life. As we identify with The Fool, we advance in that evolutionary process.
- There are many associations with the number 8, which is essentially two zeros)
- Scintillating Intelligence: Tarot Key Zero represents the purified mind that allows life
  to unfold in greater and greater splendor or Glory to the creator (See Sphere 8 on
  the Tree of Life: Glory).
- Forever Young: don't identify yourself as aging. Keep your youthful spirit forever.
- However far you have come in your development you have infinity to go, so you are always at zero.
- The shape of zero represents the seed of infinite potential that is you're true self (see the seed in Key 13, as the death of the old always carries the seed of the new).
- The shape also suggests the egg that we are always in the process of being born into the next higher level of evolution.
- The Limitless Light ever driving us to expand in total spiritual freedom.
- Liberation from all limits.
- The unlimited potential of consciousness.
- The wisdom of zero: Make nothing of everything.

Higher Wisdom is always perceived as folly to the unenlightened.

He is willing to be judged as a fool by the world, because he is more interested in being himself than in being perceived as important.

We always start out as The Fool, confronted by circumstances we don't know how to handle.

Being at the height: we always start out at a higher place than where we were before. Relative to where you used to be you are now at a mountain top of wisdom, with far greater heights to attain.

White Rose: Purified Desire – Only desire is to advance into the fulfillment of Divine Oneness, knowing that is the source of all the heart desires.

Pole on his shoulder: he does not rely on a staff to climb, meaning he mastered his ascent with ease – ease being an aspect of mastery. (Compare the pole on his shoulder to the reaper in key 13: He is reaping new information for his wallet through each transformation).

He is unencumbered: Not attached to possessions. Takes only the wisdom or lessons gained from past experience.

Wallet with eye: all The Fool takes with him are the lessons of the past to apply to his present.

Eagle on wallet: Chief among those lessons is the wisdom of how to pass through transformation or transition (see Key 13, which is The Fool going through ultimate transformation.

Green Wreath: Victory over nature through control of mental images.

Red Feather emerging from the green wreath: Mastery of the element of air or thought, with the recognition that thought produces action and stimulates passion (see the red lion in key 8).

Red Feather: rising of the kundalini energy to the third eye (see the lion's tail in key 8) – he sees the interior working of the universe.

Fancy jacket: His sparkling personality is aligned with the laws of the universe.

Red Sleeves: Free-flowing action that feels simple, easy and fun motivated by inspiration.

White undergarment: Spiritual Purity

Shoes: the style of a jester's: the wisdom of maintaining a sense of humor as you tread your path.

Golden Girdle: Master of time: turns time into gold by living in the eternal now (where nothing is happening)

Olive stockings: an earthy hue of brown and green: bringing his wisdom down to earth

## Kabbalah Path 1-2:

- Path of return: Moving up into higher wisdom.
- Path of descent or manifestation: Moving toward earthly wisdom or how to master material conditions.
- Yod Heh Vau Heh: The True Limitless I AM that creates everything out of nothing. Your True Self.
- Aleph, Ox: The power of higher self-cultivation, which is endless.
- Aleph also represents BREATH in this case The Breath of Inspiration that is deathless.
- White Dog on hind legs: Trained, cultivated, purified animal nature. (The transformation of the lion in Key 8.)
- Tail up: Kundalini rising see the lion's tail in key 8.

Mountain ledge a step down: Accepting your limitless possibilities is a high state of consciousness. But we then must descend to earthly conditions to put our wisdom to the test.

Brown earth: Maintaining the attitude of The Fool demonstrates mastery over the earthplane.

Snowy Peak in background: The pure, high spiritual state he is heading toward by descending into daily living to test out his wisdom.

Violet mts in background: Combining red (action) with blue (consciousness) meaning he climbs through acts of consciousness.

The White Sun: Represents the source of existence as a whole, as well as Spiritual Light. It represents Kether in Kabbalah, the guidance and direction of Divine Will with which The Fool is aligned.

Yellow Background: The Fool is moving through the element of air, or thought. Explore your mind to discern what you really know from what you only presume to know. This is the path of Mental Freedom.
