

Magic of Tarot Session 6 – Tarot Key5: The Hierophant Session Six Notes

Kabbalah = From Mouth To Ear

“Man does not live by bread alone, but by every word...”

Follow inner guidance to receive and give the support you need to take you to the next level.”

Tarot’s 5 Powers Of Mind

0= open-mindedness

1= concentration

2= subconscious response to concentration

3= creative imagination

4= reason

5= intuition

Tarot Key 5 conveys the way to receive the guidance of your Inner Spiritual Teacher:

- **Hearing:** The Key word for this Tarot Key is hearing. It represents both listening to the outer AND listening to the inner.
 - Notice one ear is showing and the other is hidden as one listens without and the other within.

Tallis around Neck: shaped like a yoke, which implies union. In this case, union with the True Will.

- The Neck: ruled by Taurus, the Sign of this image. The Moon (The High Priestess) is exalted in Taurus. IE: the subconscious is at its apex ready to receive messages from the Inner Teacher.
- Yellow: mind
- Purple: royalty

In a temple, like the high priestess:

- She is the subconscious ready to receive the seed-idea from her lover, the magician
- He is the subconscious in its mode of delivering intuition.

The Hierophant: Literally, revealer of the sacred.

- This image opens and attunes your mind to receive inner guidance as to how to operate within spiritual law for a triumphant outcome.

Black and White Squares:

- Sometimes living is like a chess match; seek higher intuitive guidance to support you in your next move.
- Seek inner guidance through the bright and dark
- Uniting of opposites

Gold and Silver Keys:

Guidance from the spiritual sun (gold) via the subconscious (silver)

Taurus:

- Steadfast, dependable, practical
- Moon is exalted: Moon is subconscious

Taurus

- Moon at throat
- Horns on throne

Monks:

- With Red Roses: The yoga of desire or devotion: Bhakti
 - guidance to the fulfillment of your desires (see roses with Magician)
 - Open arms: how to receive
- White Lillies: Receive the knowledge, insight, understanding you seek (see lilies with the Magician) : The Yoga of Knowledge, Jana yoga
 - Prayerful hands: expression of devotion to higher ones
 - Yellow Yokes = Yoga, Union via mental plane (yellow)

4 Circles with crosses: Mastery of the earth-plane

Crosses on white feet and hands: Uniting the material with the spiritual

Staff: Authority over the 4 worlds of Kabbalah:

The World of Origins

The World of Creation

The World of Formation

The World of Manifestation – Action

Headdress: Gold and yellow: Solar Light infusing mind

- 4 levels: Mastery of the 4 worlds.

Blue-green trim: Color associated with Scorpio (showing union of opposites), suggesting triumphant and eternal intelligence taking us beyond death.

White undergarment and shoes: Spiritual Purity

Two fingers up, two down: Suggesting he only reveals part of the truth.

Red Outer Garment, Roses, and Red carpet: This hearing both satisfies and leads to the fulfillment of your heart's desires.

VUV: Nail, fastener, union, yoga

Triumphant and Eternal Intelligence: his inner guidance leads you to Victory over time.

Pillars: Uniting of opposites

- Top design: uniting male and female forces

Purple Undergarment:
