

Mastering Manifestation:
Kabbalah Keys To Tarot Magic
Lesson 1

Intro: getting into the details of each tarot image took place in our previous series. If you feel enough interest in this deep area of self and Self investigation, the recordings are available through info@lisacampion.com.

Here we will mainly employ overviews of each image, which takes the material of our previous series to a higher level.

Astrologically we will focus on understanding, recognizing, employing and aligning with the 12 essential energy-patterns represented by the 12 signs of the zodiac.

Kabbalistically we will go into:

- The Kabbalah Tree of Life as the 10 Spheres relate to manifesting “outwardly” and “inwardly”
 - A schemata of God’s powers and process and your divine nature
 - A schemata of the manifestation process
 - The path of return
- The Shekinah and your purpose
- hidden meanings of the Hebrew alphabet and how to employ their creative power,
- the 4 worlds or dimensions of your existence, and how to move through them, including work with angels and archangels
- the secret meanings and applications of the four sacred letters of the “Name of Names” of the Divine: yod – heh – vuv - heh.

Our basic foundation will, of course, be The New Wisdom Of Joy, Using The Method; because joy is always the point and misery breeds malice.

The essential messages of today’s class

- Aries: the first sign of the zodiac
 - Representing the power to begin, to take action, to “use your head”
- Kether: all of creation starts here, with intention
 - The first Sphere on the Tree of Life, representing “The crown on the head of the Divine Human, Will, the originating point in the creation of the cosmos
- The first letter of the Tetragramaton
 - Yod: representing essence of will, origination, the open hand, The Hermit
- Aleph:
 - The first letter of the Hebrew Alphabet, representing the INFINITE (ain soph) Power that is our essence
 - Also represents the ox, the power that endlessly drives the cosmic process
- The Fool (key 0):

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- Image of Infinite Consciousness, Ain Soph, the driving force behind creation and our evolutionary process
- The Magician (Key 1)
 - Representing Kether, the power of concentration, how we direct creation with the power of single-pointed attention
- Atziluth: the world of origins
 - Yod
 - The highest of the Four Worlds in which you live
- Introducing angels and archangels of Kether
 - These are the “conveyers” of the energy of The Crown
 - Divine Name: through Atziluth
 - Archangels: through Briah
 - Angels: through Yetzirah
 - The 4 elements of the natural world (physical manifestation) Assiah
- Introducing the Shekinah
 - This is the feminine “half” of the Divine
 - According to the Zohar, the purpose of the human being is to bring the Shekinah (God’s nature in the material world) to earth – this completes the Divine Plan
 - We achieve this by following our highest course of action

Quote: “No matter how nice the prison, you want to be free.”

From The Zohar

“Rabbi Eleazor asked Rabbi Simeon; ... To what heights does the attachment of the will... extend? He said: We have already taught that it extends to en-soph, for all attachments, unifications, and completions is to be secreted in that secret which is not perceived or known, and which contains the will of all wills.”

God is the master manifester and zero stands between union with what God wills.

- How to will like god: imagine no space between where you are and where you want to be.
- **Aries** begins by busting out of limits.
 - Boldness, initiative, self-starter, action-oriented, quick to judge from appearances, blunt, impatience (learn how to create NOW)
 - Aries rules the head:
 - Here is where the beginnings of action take place
 - Rule your head and you rule your world
 - Think about an action enough and you must take it
- The Magician is Kether, focusing the infinite energy and consciousness of Ain Soph with a directed, intentional state of concentration.

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- The impact of Ain Soph on The Magician:
 - whatever “house” of life you build, a force drives you toward expansion
- Aries, Kether, The Magician and the number 1 all represent and express the power to begin things.
- Key 0 is called the fool, because it represents
 - The mindless or thoughtless state
 - being mindless of all limitation – the “everything is possible” mindset
- this card and number express Ain Soph, the limitless light that composes all form before it forms.

Key 1 is Sphere 1, Kether, Divine Will.

- “The Admirable Intelligence
 - Because it represents a state of awareness deeper than consciousness – see the quote from the Zohar
- It represents the act of focusing Ain Soph through (tzim-tzum)
 - self-determined concentration on conscious union with the point of innermost intention.
- This action passes into the subconsciousness of the Divine Mind (Key 2, The High Priestess) and through that medium manifests the fruition of that intention.
- **This is all represented in the God’s Name of Names, the Tetragramaton, YOD HEH VUV HEH.**
 - Focusing on that name and remembering what it means attunes and awakens you the power and process of it that you possess.

The Hebrew Letter assigned to number 1 is beth, which means house.

- A house is where you concentrate all the energy of the universe into your space of dwelling.
- In manifestation it represents the “house” of your life, your “dwelling place” the overall state of consciousness in which you abide.
 - The Magician and Aries teach us how to rule this house

Living with Ain Soph:

- Whatever you create through your intention will have to expand;
 - Your life structure must dissolve to allow a more expanded structure to take its place
 - All loss is the prelude to greater gain.

The risks of Aries energy:

- To push things so hard and fast that you lose the motivation needed to persevere long enough to attain complete victory.

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- To be so headstrong, willful, self-centered and combative that you undermine mutual support relationships
- To clash, to combat, to conflict rather to harmonious flow with the energy of change in a harmonious way (we learn more about this in our study of Taurus)
- The aries can feel crushed when he/she does not come out on top, is not treated as number 1, if desired results do not come “quickly enough”

Lonesome Aries

- Aries often involves seclusion as its function is to
 - Be true to the self, concerned with the self
 - The beginning stages need incubation to develop
- The Aries Ritual:
 - Tie a rope around your waste, representing zero, ain soph
 - Stand tall in that circumference and concentrate on receiving your innermost intention,

Regarding the Name of Names:

Yod = the essence of what you intend to manifest, “handed” over to

Heh = the vision of what you intend, automatically transmits through

Vuv = the link to

Heh = the final appearance in manifest form
